Professional licence or registration — confirmed

PQR §1.3.1 and §13.1.8 require a valid licence or registration to practise in the home country and/or the country of last employment, where applicable.

Good Standing Certificate — confirmed

Valid and not older than six months at the time of applying. Normally issued by the health regulatory authority in the country of last employment. Where that country has no regulatory body for the profession, an officially issued certificate from the last employer may be accepted.

PQR §1.3.3 requires it; §1.3.3.1 sets the six-month limit and §1.3.3.2 sets who may issue it, with the exception where no regulator exists.
